Educating the youth on animal welfare

PFC offers FREE animal welfare education to our community, with a particular focus on our youth. We believe that building awareness in the younger generation, while helping to nurture the bond between companion animals and people, will lead to more humane treatment for all animals.

Our program facilitates lessons of compassion, respect and the 5 basic needs of companion animals.

Community outreach and pet protection

PFC teachers hold workshops to educate our community on Animal Welfare. A few of the topics includes; how to raise abandoned kittens, responsible pet ownership, protecting pets from being poisoned, the importance of sterilizing and general pet care.










The basic needs of pets





Sterilisation to reduce overpopulation

With the world already full of stray and abandoned animals, it's vital that pet owners take responsibility and sterilise to make sure that they're not contributing to that number of unwanted animals.

In Vietnam, these unwanted animals could end up as victims to the dog and cat meat trade.

As a part of this program we vaccinate animals against rabies.

Ending the cat and dog meat trade

The dog and cat meat trade is one of our top animal welfare priorities. The sad reality of this trade is unregulated movement, slaughter, and sale of millions of dogs and cats every year, with Vietnam demanding the highest amount of meat.

These animals are mistreated, stolen and poisoned as a result of this cruel industry.

Ending this trade is our main focus, through educating on animal welfare and mass sterilisation



All our animals are up for adoption.

















Dogs and cats are sentient creatures, which means they can feel pain and have emotions and feelings, just like humans.

Living as pets with an owner or living on the streets without an owner











5 basic needs 1.FOOD & WATER

Dogs and cats can be hungry and thirsty, so they need food and water everyday.

Animals should have access to fresh, clean water at all times and should be given the adequate type and amount of food to keep them fit and healthy









5 basic needs2. LOVE & ATTENTION

Animals can sometimes be scared and you need to be nice to them.

Animals need to be kept in conditions that mean they will not suffer or feel pain, and they need to be treated in a way that does not frighten them or cause distress

We are lucky that we can give all these beautiful animals all the love they need.








5 basic needs

3. EXERCISE & NATURAL BEHAVIOUR

Animals need enough space to run and play every day.

Animals need company (some don't) of other animals of their own kind, enough space and appropriate facilities so they can express natural behaviour.











5 basic needs 4. SHELTER


Animals need a place where they can rest and hide from the heat, the rain or from pet thieves.

Animals need a suitable place to live. They should be provided with the adequate type of home, including shelter, space and opportunities to exercise and a comfortable place to rest and hide.

Animals should also not be closed in a cage all day.









5 basic needs5. MEDICAL CARE

Animals can get sick or be wounded (I.e. broken leg) and then they will need a veterinarian (= doctor for animals).

Animals should only be treated by a vet if they are sick or injured as soon as possible.
